Dear Governor Cuomo,

On July 1, 1987, your father, Governor Mario Cuomo, signed into law the New York City Transit Police Variable Supplements Fund legislation in a faithful point of justice, being the basis of our lawful Collective Bargaining Agreement with our then employer the New York City Transit Authority. Terms of the agreement were to ensure parity in all benefits with our counterparts in the NYC police force.

These terms, were infringed upon by the intent of unfaithful trustees of the Transit Police Variable Supplements Fund against the INTERESTS OF CERTAIN BENEFICIARIES. Unpinning the integrity and responsibility of trusteeship to those they lawfully represent. Acting in complicity since 1991, the trustees in July 24, 1992 (Laws of 1992, chapter 577, Senate bill 8811A, Assembly bill 12195) supported their legislation against pre-1987 "for service" twenty year retirees who now were to be denied their benefit after five years in the fund as beneficiaries and contributors (as per SKIMS from NYCERS).

Governor, I'm writing and asking on behalf of my family and myself, that we are looking forward to your support for justice in signing into law legislative Senate bill S6823A, Assembly bill A8585A, to correct this injustice and restore the lawful and righteous intent of our Collective Bargaining Agreement with our employer and that of your father, Governor Mario Cuomo.

In ending, let me say, this has been a telling story of the truth and a quest for justice.
